After my acquisition of Furnierwerk Laubach GmbH & Co. KG, about 1½ year ago, we have invested significant resources into improving our veneer production line and into a new power plant on the premises.

Energiewerk Laubach:

- The building of a 7,5 MW power plant commenced 11th August 2009.
- District heating is planned and contractually agreed for early 2010 within the Laubach community.
- The advantages of our power plant include a more reliable energy supply for our main business which continues to be rotary cut beech veneer by using wood which is not suitable for veneer generated during production. Besides strengthening our market position it allows us to view the future with confidence as we have developed a new area of operations and can supply the energy we require to ourselves.

Furnierwerk Laubach:


- Now has two highly technical, specialized camera systems with the ability to detect the quality which our customers require on both production lines.
- Other investments include a prolongation of our sorting line and a scanner we use for quality-control as our logs enter production.
- Further we have qualified for and obtained FSC as well as PEFC certification, which will be of great benefit to our customers.
- As of today we are also able to offer you rotary cut oak veneer.

Marianne Nygaard joins the team:

- As of August 1st 2009 Mrs. Marianne Nygaard has joined the Reuttner group as sales director.
- Her main aim is to internationalize and professionalize our veneer sales.
