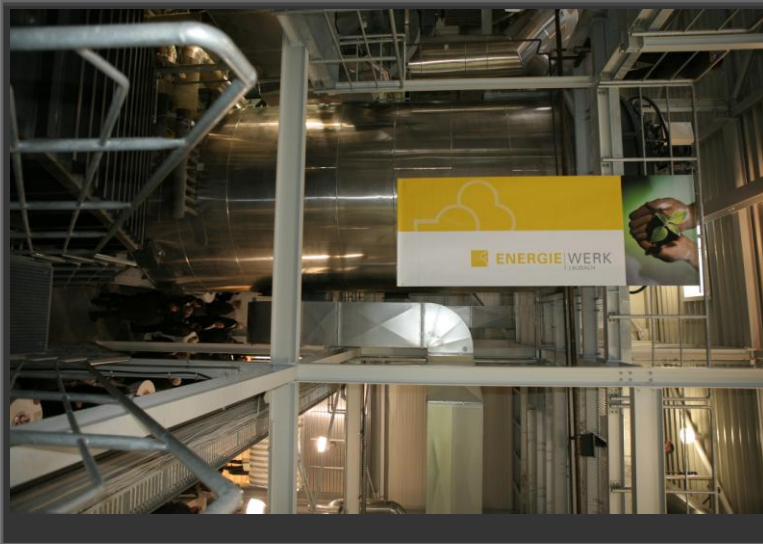


NEWS FROM THE "REUTTNER GROUP"

FSC and PEFC certification was obtained end of 2009 to guarantee a sustainable forestry.



On the 25th February 2010 we opened our 7,5 MW power plant during a brief ceremony to which many interested persons from all walks of life including politicians, business persons and journalists came to Laubach.

The plant has now been steadily supplying process heat to the veneer mill for several weeks and we are expecting to be able to increase our output due to this reliable, modern source of energy.



In the last quarter of 2009 Mr. Glass, our leading technician and assistant to our production manager Mr. Krauss, has been working on a quality management system which we have introduced in January 2010 and are implementing presently. We are paying particular attention to parameters such as moisture, veneer dimensions and packaging.

At the same time Mr. Krauss, Mr. Glass and their team have been doing some R & D with peeled Oak veneer and we are proud to let you know that this has been successful.

As of November 2009 Furnierwerk Laubach is certified to both FSC and PEFC standards. We store our logs separately (as required by the certifier) and can therefore guarantee the necessary chain of custody in both cases.



General forecast

In general business has been picking up in the last Quarter 2009 and has developed well in the first quarter 2010.

We are expecting to reach the same output as 2007, possibly more.

Due to this circumstance we require a lead time from the purchasing order arriving until the veneer can leave the mill of around 5 - 6 weeks.

Of course we are trying to accommodate as many of our customers' needs as possible and exceptions are being made occasionally, but we would cordially ask you to consider this lead time before placing an order, because this helps avoid disappointment make our lives much easier!
